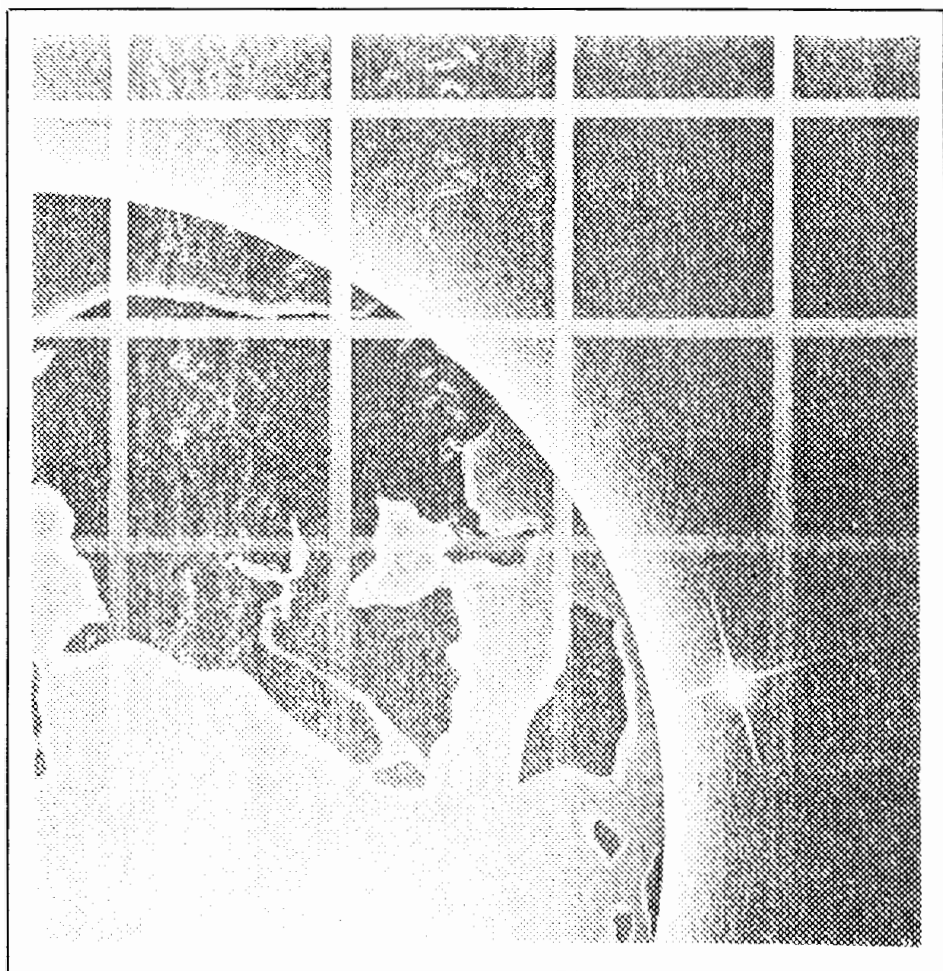

DOCUMENTATION

The Windows Disk includes all the programs from the book *The Complete Rainbow Guide to OS-9 Level II, Volume I: A Beginners Guide to Windows*, written by Dale L. Puckett and Peter Dibble. All of the programs are ready to run using the following information in conjunction with the instructions included in the book. This disk is considered an adjunct to the book. You will need the book in order to understand the programs on this disk.

The programs are supplied on one 35-track, single-sided, double-density disk formatted for Color Computer OS-9. They are intended for use with a Radio Shack Color Computer 3 running OS-9 Level II. While some of the programs will work in a 128K machine, most of them, especially those in later chapters, require 512K. This is because the programs are designed to be operated using windows, and windows take a lot of memory.

In keeping with established standards, all directories on The Windows Disk are named in all uppercase letters. Filenames are in mostly lowercase letters. Only some characters in filenames have been capitalized to help clarify the program's function.

All programs preceding `Shapes.Bas` in Chapter 7 are procedure files. They contain OS-9 commands and can be run from the OS-9 prompt just by entering the name of the file. All programs from `Shapes.Bas` on are BASIC09 programs. You will need to be running BASIC09 before you load these files. They are not packed.

You will need to read *The Complete Rainbow Guide to OS-9 Level II, Volume I: A Beginners Guide to Windows* to understand how each of the programs is to be used. Each program has its own unique operating instructions.

This disk contains 13 directories named `CHAPTER.4`, `CHAPTER.5` and `CHAPTER.7` through `CHAPTER.17`. Each of these directories contains procedure files and/or BASIC09 source files. To use these programs requires some knowledge of OS-9's directory structure. You will need to be familiar with importance and usage of the `chd` command. This subject is addressed in Chapter 1 and again in Chapter 9 of the book. If you have little understanding of OS-9, it would be wise to purchase a copy of *The Complete Rainbow Guide to OS-9*. This book contains plenty of information regarding the basics of the OS-9 operating system for Level I and Level II environments.

Our last piece of advice is a safeguard. **MAKE A BACKUP!** The first thing you should do with this disk after booting OS-9 is make a backup. If you don't know how, consult your OS-9 manual. It is also discussed in Chapter 1 of *The Complete Rainbow Guide to OS-9 Level II, Volume I: A Beginners Guide to Windows*. Always work from your backup and use the enclosed master only in the event something should happen to your backup.
