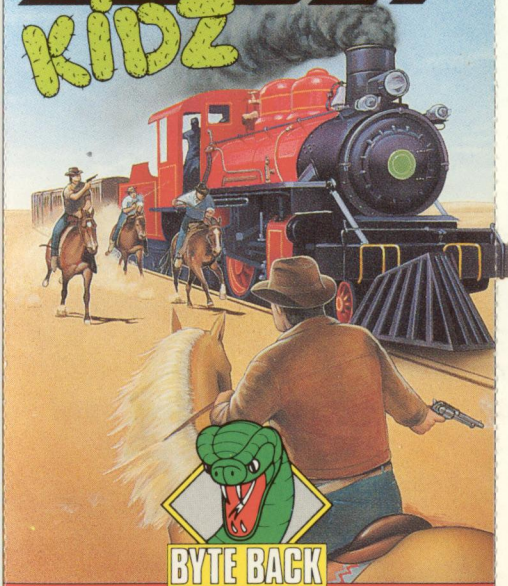

to contend with. In addition some of the bad guys might get onto the train and begin taking pot shots at you from there.

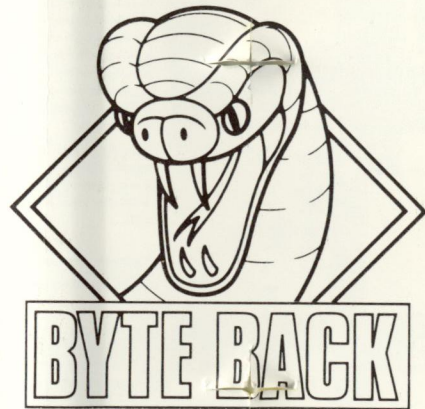
CONTROLS:
